EMEAC urges legislators to fund commuter rail

In June 2002, EMEAC sent letters to three State Senators and three State Representatives urging them to support funding for commuter rail from Lansing to Detroit as they review the Transportation Budget. Up to \$1 million has been allocated for the final phase of the Lansing to Detroit Commuter Rail Study. The rail system will be implemented in segments focusing first on the segment from Ann Arbor to Detroit with a stop at the Detroit International Airport.
